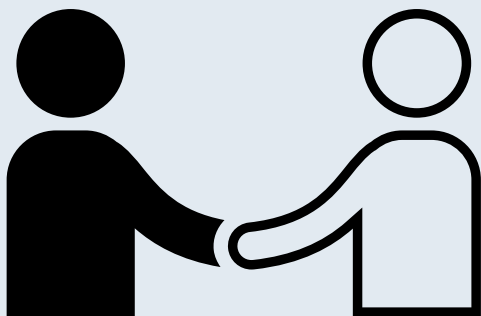
This brochure presents the basic principles of professional ethics, tolerance, non-discrimination, and fundamental human rights.

Professional ethics is a set of moral principles and behavioral norms that professionals must follow in their work.

Key components of professional ethics:

- Honesty
- Integrity
- Transparency
- Accountability
- Confidentiality
- Objectivity
- Respectfulness
- Obedience to the law



Tolerance as the Foundation of Society

Tolerance is respect, acceptance, and understanding of the diversity of views, religions, cultures, traditions, and personal characteristics of others.

- Why is tolerance important?
- Promotes peace and safety
- Builds trust
- Improves communication

Practical Expressions of Tolerance

Tolerance toward different cultures:

- Respecting cultural differences
- Avoiding stereotypes

Tolerance toward religious beliefs:

- Neutral attitude toward religious symbols
- Providing space for prayers

Tolerance toward people with disabilities:

- Creating accessible environments
- Showing respectful attitudes
